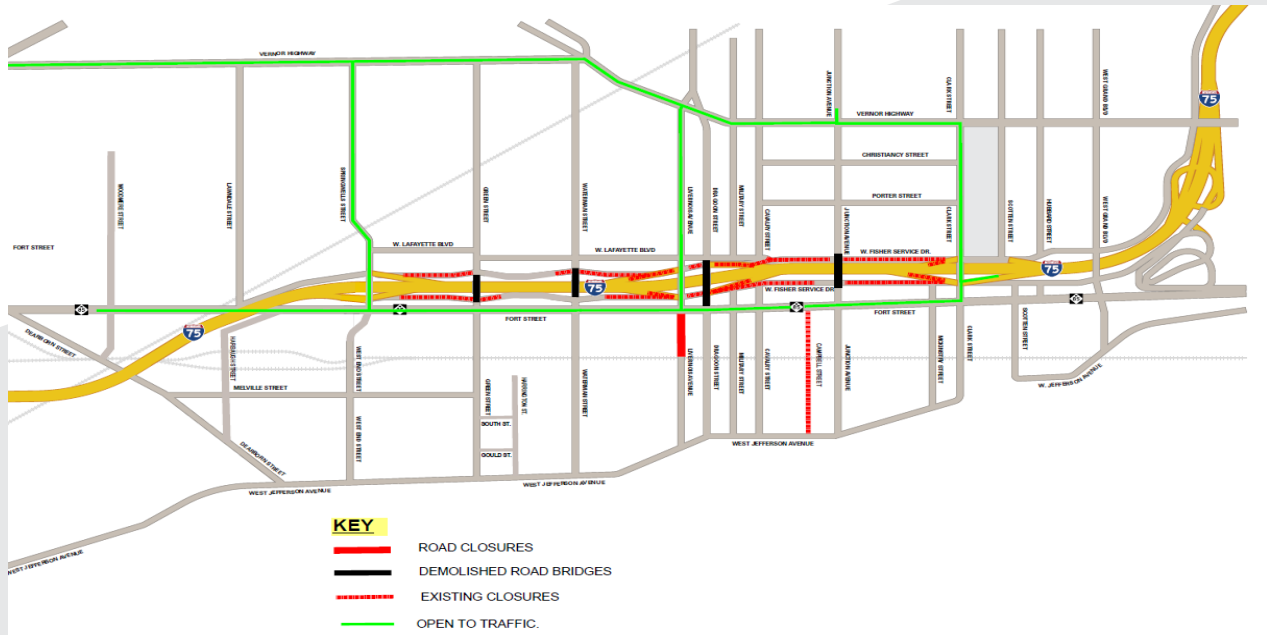

THE PROJECT

The Gordie Howe International Bridge project between Windsor, ON and Detroit, MI will help move goods and people more efficiently at this important trade gateway. Managed by Windsor-Detroit Bridge Authority (WDBA) working in collaboration with the State of Michigan, the project is being delivered through a public private partnership (P3) which will see Bridging North America design, build, finance, operate and maintain the bridge.

The existing closure on Livernois Avenue between Norfolk Southern Railroad tracks and Fort Street will remain in place until summer 2024.
